

HOW TO MAKE A FURTHER SUBMISSION

Any person may make a further submission on the Proposed Plan Change 2 to the Regional Coastal Plan for the West Coast.

Written submissions should be addressed to:
The Planning and Environmental Manager
West Coast Regional Council
P.O. Box 66
Greymouth

Please ensure that we receive your submission by **5:00pm, Friday 27th March 2009**.

Your submission should state:

- ◆ Full name and address for service.
- ◆ The nature of your submission, whether you support or oppose one or more of the original submissions.
- ◆ The specific submissions to which your further submission relates.
- ◆ The reasons for your support or opposition to the decision requested.
- ◆ Whether or not you wish to be heard at a hearing in support of your submission.
- ◆ Whether, if others make a similar submission, you would or would not be prepared to consider presenting a joint case with them at any hearing.

Your submission must be signed and dated.

Following receipt of written further submissions, the Regional Council will adopt the following procedure:

- ◆ By way of public notice, advice will be given of the places where the summary of submissions and the submissions themselves can be inspected.
- ◆ A Staff Report on the submissions and further submissions will be prepared.
- ◆ The Council will hold public hearings, if required.
- ◆ The Council will make its decisions and notify submitters of these.
- ◆ Any person who lodges a submission or further submission, who is not satisfied with the Council's decisions and the changes that may be made to the Proposed Plan Change 2 to the Regional Coastal Plan for the West Coast, may then refer the matters to the Environment Court.
- ◆ Once all matters referred to the Environment Court are resolved, the document will become operative.
