Thanks for furnishing the powerpoint and visiting me re the proposal . the proposal has some cultural issues namely the reduction of the Mangatini catchment waters and their diversion directly to the ocean outfall. As stated in other cultural Impact Assessments this is detrimental to the mauri of the place and awa. Though in this case cleaning up of the toxic waters of the Mangatini catchment is positive, though Ngati Waewae is aware and supportive of SENZ initiatives here too via the Mangatini sump development, to name but one.

As stated earlier we need to progress our CIA for the proposal, as this is so close to SENZ Cypress proposal and linked via St Pats dam proposal the HDL CIA will be a briefer document. The Cypress CIA document commissioned by SENZ is now a public document on their and WCRC file. I have attached it for your information.

Waewae were pleased to agree to be contracted to develop and forward the HDL CIA as part of information for the HDL lodgement of consent with WCRC.

Please keep us informed of progress and any changes to the proposal, two site visits as part of the CIA contract would be essential.
