Update to proposed TTPP maps

Feedback received from the community and stakeholders on the recently released proposed Te Tai o Poutini Plan (TTPP) has been welcomed by the Committee.

Rex Williams, TTPP Chair, said that an issue had been identified with the GIS mapping of some sites, particularly those close to waterbodies, where the digital map had misaligned with the physical maps.

“We will be making contact with individual landowners where this issue occurs over the next couple of weeks to rectify this and explain where it has occurred,” said Mr Williams.

“We are also aware that there have been some problems accessing the Plan online, either due to an incorrect web address or slow loading speed.”

The Plan can be accessed at www.tpp.nz and work is being completed to boost the website’s ability to handle a large volume of activity.

“On behalf of the Committee, I want to thank the community for their interest in the proposed Plan, as well as their patience as we work through these issues. We acknowledge that these issues are not ideal but have provided for an extended submission period to receive feedback.”

Submissions on the proposed Plan close at 5.00pm 30 September.
