West Coast flooding

There has been a significant amount of rainfall across the West Coast region today. The primary areas of concern have been Hokitika, and north to Greymouth.

Buller District has also been monitoring the situation but no active response has been required.

Grey District Council civil defence response was required through to mid-afternoon. The team remains on stand-by until the weather system passes.

Westland District Council staff and relevant agencies met twice today. Staff here will also continue to monitor the situation for any further developments.
