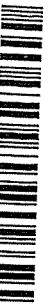

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

No rock on the Tarkine gravel bank it will need rock in the future as it is very exposed.

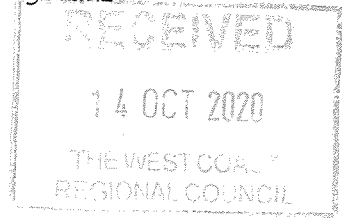

Waiho River works

First and foremost – Unblock the river from the Waiho bridge down to Canavan's Knob. Over the years boulders have accumulated in the river bed after being "blown out" during flooding events. Once the river drops after a flood, the shingle aggrades upstream of the boulders raising the river bed. This is a continuous vicious cycle.

No to building a stop bank below the oxidation ponds. In my time here over the last twenty years the Waiho River, during extreme rain events, has partially flowed towards the Tartare Gorge. This has acted as a "safety valve", let it continue to do so. I believe that if a stop bank is placed here it will only exacerbate the problem of land erosion for the farm and also place other properties at risk due to back scouring depending on which way the river decides to take.

From the end of the existing Heliport stop bank, build a new stop bank in a straight line towards the oxidation ponds. After the ponds, gently curve back towards the southern end of the Waiho Loop for 100-200 metres. Armour this entire bank with rip rap (NO SPURS) by digging down at least 4 metres (or engineer approved specification) and back filling to bed level. The boulders dug out from below the bridge could be utilised here (must be cheaper than trucking from Whataroa). Conversely, perhaps consideration should be given to utilising the new interlocking concrete blocks that have been developed by Westlock Concrete Solutions, (which featured on One News) that are being installed at Granity to combat coastal erosion – local company, local jobs! The space behind this new stop bank (to the north) should be back filled with shingle out of the river, leaving a gap along the existing stop bank (Havill Wall) for town storm water.

Logic dictates that by keeping the river narrow below the bridge will create a faster flow especially during floods. Think of a garden hose – you're going to have more success shifting dirt off your drive way with a jet of water rather than a fan.

As the land north of the existing stop bank currently sits below or level with the river, consideration should be given to back filling the entire area encompassing the old DOC carpark, main road and down to the oxidation ponds up to the level of the main road. You need to take into account the fact that the Tonkin Taylor report suggested removing 300,000 cubic metres of shingle per year –that is 20 rugby fields 3 metres deep!

With reference to the River Report commissioned by the Westland Regional Council circa 2009, four areas were identified where the Waiho River could breach:

- Below the oxidation ponds and flowing towards the Tartare Gorge
- "Pub Corner" (or 55km Corner)

- Across State Highway 6, adjacent to Douglas Drive
- Via a saddle/cutting upstream of the Waiho Bridge (connecting to Cron Street near the YHA)

The Waiho River has so far breached two of these areas. I believe that continuing to raise the stopbank and therefore the bridge only exacerbates the risk to the township itself should the Waiho River decide to breach upstream of the bridge.

Wait for Mother Nature to do her thing to take out the south end of the Waiho Loop or give her a helping hand. There is already erosion occurring at the southern end of the Loop so let's help her along. By taking out the end it will create a straighter route for the river thereby allowing the water to move faster transporting more shingle towards the sea, rather than the river slowing down and dumping shingle.

DO NOT let the river go south, especially between the Waiho Bridge and Canavan's Knob. We don't want another environmental disaster like the one that occurred at Fox where the old landfill was compromised. The old landfill adjacent to Canavan's Knob doesn't seem to have been taken into account in the Tonkin Taylor report. Also there are a lot of livelihoods to take into consideration on the south side of the Waiho River, not forgetting State Highway 6 and the airstrip which will be invaluable during emergencies.

Highly ambitious and way out of left field! Build a substantial concrete spillway, similar to what is seen in Los Angeles, on the south side of the Waiho River, The entry point could be just upstream of the confluence of the Callery River, running down past the south side of Canavan's Knob and exiting either above or below Rata Knoll. During flood events this would take pressure off the river channel downstream of the Callery. For ease of maintenance some access ramps could be incorporated into the design enabling trucks and loaders to clear the spillway of flood debris after the water has subsided.

To Whom It May Concern:

Unfortunately due to the C-19 pandemic we do not have any income let alone disposable income to support this proposed economic stimulus package. I am sure we are not the only people in this boat being a tourist town with next to no tourism income.

My 1st Question; How many people in the Franz community is the \$1.9 million divided by and over what time frame is this proposal to be rated?

My rough calculation is approximately 400 people live in the area, which would be \$4750 per person. To me that is a lot of money under the current conditions we are faced with.

As your letter reads the affected areas are the Heliport and anything west of Rata Knoll in which the Heliport Owners, Aircraft Operators and Property Owners west of Rata Knoll are the effected parties not the northern extent of the proposed new rating district. People who own property to the north have chosen to live free and away from the unpredictable Waiho river so I don't believe they should be involved in any co-funding of this project when it will not benefit or will any of the money be spent in the north area.

Having seen first hand how much volume of gravel is above the bridge and how much is accumulating above the bridge that will make its way down the valley in the next 10 years, A 2m wall would be a waste of time and money in my opinion. Maybe let the Waiho join with the lower Tatare and flow through the Mid Wahio Loop and out the north side of the west end of the Valley where there is no infrastructure.

Other options need to be explored for the bridge such as a road along the top of the Waiho Loop and a bridge that spans across to Rata Knoll south.
