


BEL advises that there are 2 concerns:

1. Working near high voltage lines requires a “close approach application” to be completed and signed off by BEL before the work starts.
2. The stopbank clearance from ground to the line may be reduced and if this distance falls below the legal minimum clearance The West Coast Regional Council will be accountable for all costs to maintain the legal clearance.

Dear Paulette Birchfield,

Thank you for meeting with me on Friday the 26th April 2019, to discuss WCRC upgrade to the Karamea Stopbank from the Last Resort to the Karamea Bridge.

As discussed, I was very surprised that I haven't been notified of the upgrade and timeframe involved, especially since it will have such an impact on our business with approximately half of the proposed work running through our place.

Andrew did mention that you had called in unannounced one day when I wasn't here to say you were looking to upgrade the stopbank but nothing was discussed in detail.

Andrew attended a West Coast Regional Council committee member meeting on Tuesday the 23rd April 2019 and came home saying he thought everyone had known about the stopbank upgrade and the starting date for work to begin of 1st June 2019, except him.

As you can imagine this time frame of the 1st June is a great shock for us. We planted a crop in November 2018 for grazing off this winter and spring and we have just regrassed a paddock in permanent pasture. Both these paddocks are right next to the stopbank. We have a very intensive dairy farming operation and rely on every bit of feed we can get.

We think the stopbank upgrade is a good idea and we support your efforts to keep Karamea township protected but we have some concerns on how it will affect our business. These are;

1. The stop bank behind the Karamea River Motels will encroach a lot more onto our private land and it will be a lot larger.

We would like to get a written guarantee that all the stop bank on our property, will be put back into grass and will still be available for us to graze with our cows normally (without using as a standoff) without interruption.

For example, no walking/cycle tracks and no public access on stopbank.

2. Not too much interruption to our business

The timeframe we would prefer is January to March 2020. Hopefully it will be drier then and it would suit our business much better.

3. We have two access points for vehicles and livestock going over the stopbank. Next to the Karamea bridge and alongside the Karamea River Motels.

We also discussed the access going out from the cowshed.

Please could we have these well made with a good gradient so a vehicle can drive over them without bellying.

4. You mentioned that the three old rata trees would need to be cut down and removed. Even though I can understand why this must be done, it grates rather a lot to see our neighbour is getting away with growing trees and scrubs on the stopbank.

It also looks like you have moved the stopbank way out onto our place behind the motels so it accommodates them.

If the trees must come down we would take them for firewood.

5. We are guessing that once the new stopbank is completed then everything would be returned to how it was. Fencing in and regressed in a good grass clover mix (not something silly like Nui).

6. One question, as I didn't know this was happening do the rest of Karamea know? Do they need notifying in the chronicle?

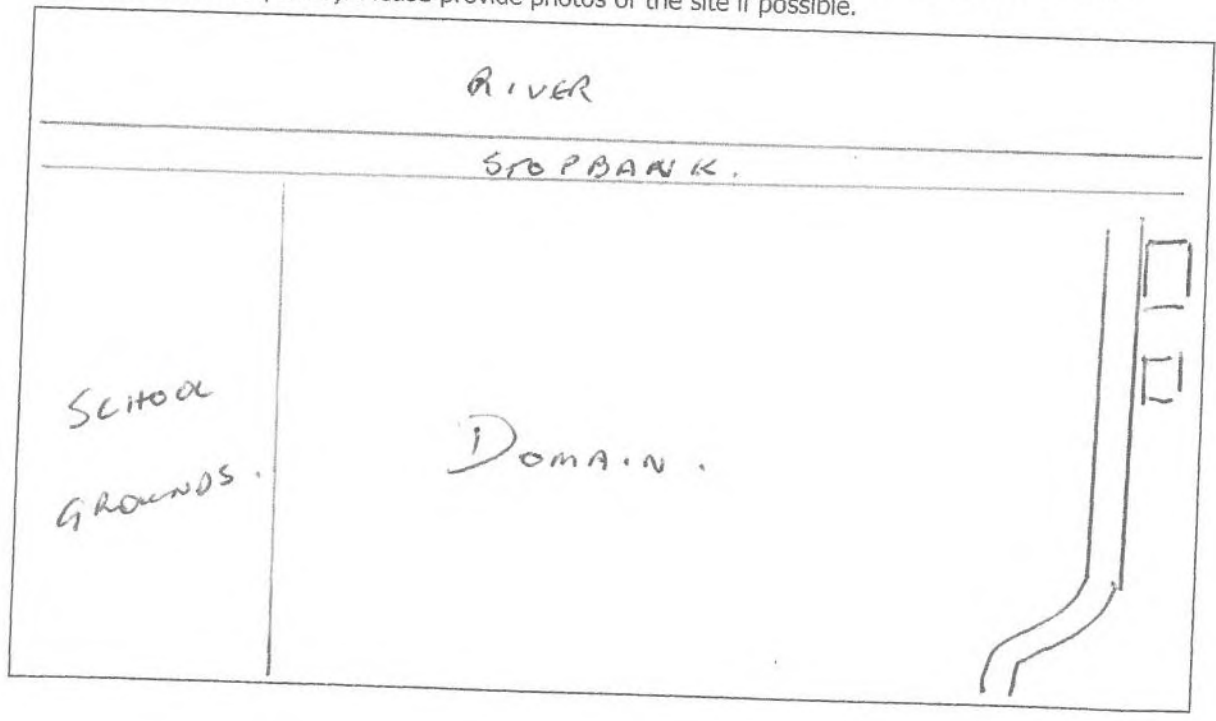

In fact, the greatest environmental risk to my section is river flooding, which I understand from long-term residents, has occurred occasionally. Meanwhile, there are no plans or funds to protect properties such as mine from the risk of river flooding. 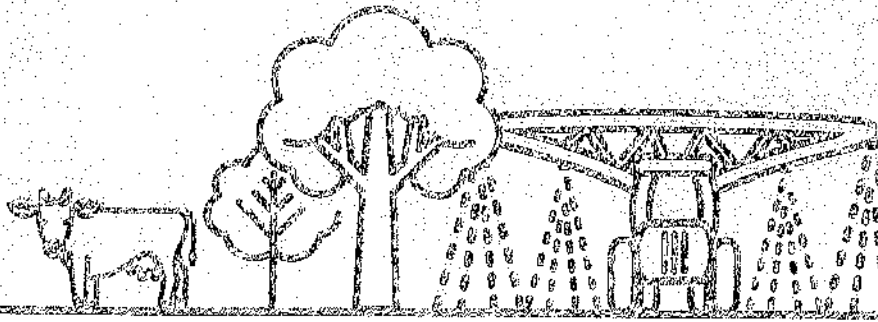

Re proposal for Rapahoe Rating District: I feel I am left but with no option to vote against this proposal as I am unable to make any informed choice based on the consultation information provided (the lack thereof). I understand that this has been initiated at the request of the community, however I would expect more detail on the advantages/disadvantages of the proposal to be provided by the WCRC. This includes: -Which properties benefit? Is it only those directly behind the wall? -What is the estimated useful life of the wall? -Are there any properties that would be negatively affected by such a wall? -Is there a detrimental affect to the amenity values of the beach? -What is the preferred option of the Regional Council as the organisation with the statutory responsibility? - What process has the Council undertaken to assess the benefits now and into the future, and then subsequently assess how it is to be funded? -Did Council consider 'ability to pay' as a part of the proposal and what other funding options have been considered by the Council. There has already been an acceptance that many properties that do not benefit at all should still pay if option 1 or option 2 were to proceed. Why is a targeted rate the only option considered? I also cannot accept the statement that "Council advises that if major works are undertaken in the future that the scheme agreed to for the 20/21 year will also apply to who pays for future major works." As there is no context to what such major future works might entail and what they might cost it is not accepted that we are expected to express our opinion now on a future unknown quantity. It seems to me that by consulting and making decisions in this manner only serves to divide the community based on an individual reluctance to pay and therefore there is an inevitability that the majority will vote against it. The decision is therefore not ultimately based on the merits of the proposal but rather the majority view of a small number of ratepayers expected to pay for it. Does that make for good quality decision making by our elected members?

Submission – Rapahoe Proposed Rating District (Submitted by the Affected Parties)

In 2006 Ocel Consultants completed a wave refraction analysis report on the Rapahoe Bay.

The purpose of the report was part of our resource consent due diligence process to establish whether our proposed subdivision would be affected by sea erosion, contrary to the Phalet report, Ian Goss (Ocel) concluded that there would be no significant erosion to our property because of the Point Elizabeth protection.

Mr Goss informed us that if protection work (like the work the Regional Council is currently proposing) took place it would have a detrimental consequence to our property subjecting our prime beach front area to inevitable erosion.

These comments arose because at this particular time, Fletcher was constructing a short wall to protect the camping ground.

Mr Goss explained to us that the construction of the Fletcher Breakwater was a complete waste of time, money and effort. He predicted that the wall would collapse which it indeed did and within quick succession.

Mr Goss warned that if a sea wall was to extend to the Rapahoe Hotel portion of the beach, it will force a reaction that will severely affect our beach frontage property, giving us no choice but to proceed with 3 extremely costly groins to rectify the problem and save our land from dramatic erosion.

In this knowledge, is the Council willing to commit to the required remedial work and construct 3 groins at the Councils expense?

Simply transferring one problem to create an event which will transpire to create erosion to another persons property is not acceptable (especially for a Council to make such a decision).

I believe the Council already has the Ocel report but we can provide this on request if necessary.

However, a solution to West Coast erosion issues is in sight. Particularly for the township of Rapahoe.

Over the 48 years that our family has owned our property we have had various proposals for the development of a deep water port at Rapahoe.

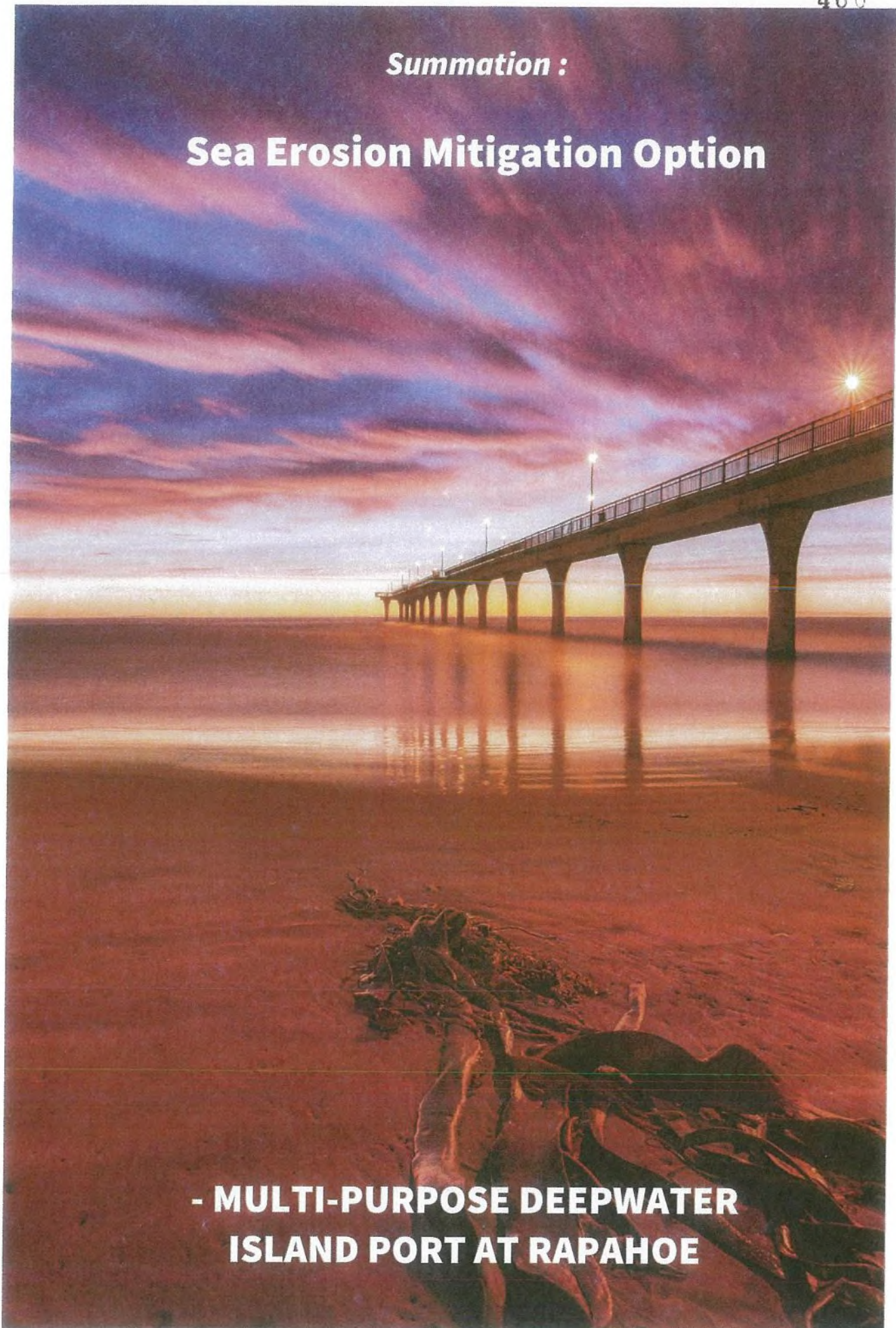

While there is not known to be any current proposals, strategically for the region, it is considered that Rapahoe has the potential to be a viable safe anchorage for feeder ships to main deep sea ports and it could also be used for tourist vessels in the future

Rapahoe is the only location with a deep channel sheltered Island Port which allows for safe passage of 30,000 to 50,000 tonne capacity ships.

Competitive Export and Import costs have always been a challenge for our area.

A port with the capacity that Rapahoe can offer would attract industry and allow for our area to capitalize on manufacturing and industrial opportunities allowing a highly competitive on board loading cost for us to export produce.

Our region has a diverse mineral profile. Our full mineral potential has not scratched the surface and is yet to be extensively explored.

We have substantial deposits of bituminous coal, gold, platinum, titanium bearing ilmenite and many other minerals. Our abundance of natural spring water is another export market opportunity that could be explored. Recent resource consent applications have been lodged to draw up to 1.3million cubic metres of water annually from Bruce Bay.

A significant amount of time/cost can be saved by having the exporting/importing capabilities available on the West Coast of the South Island (Rapahoe). The location alone would shave off at least 3 days of shipping time compared to Lyttelton.

Safety aspects considered, the Greymouth River bar is very shallow in depth and the dangers have been well documented over the years. Rapahoe would offer a sheltered birth and safe entry to and from the island port for our fishing vessels.

The rupture of the Alpine Fault line is scientifically over due. The West Coast could be cut off from supplies for days on end.

The existence of the Deep Water Port could allow for supplies to reach us in such an event.

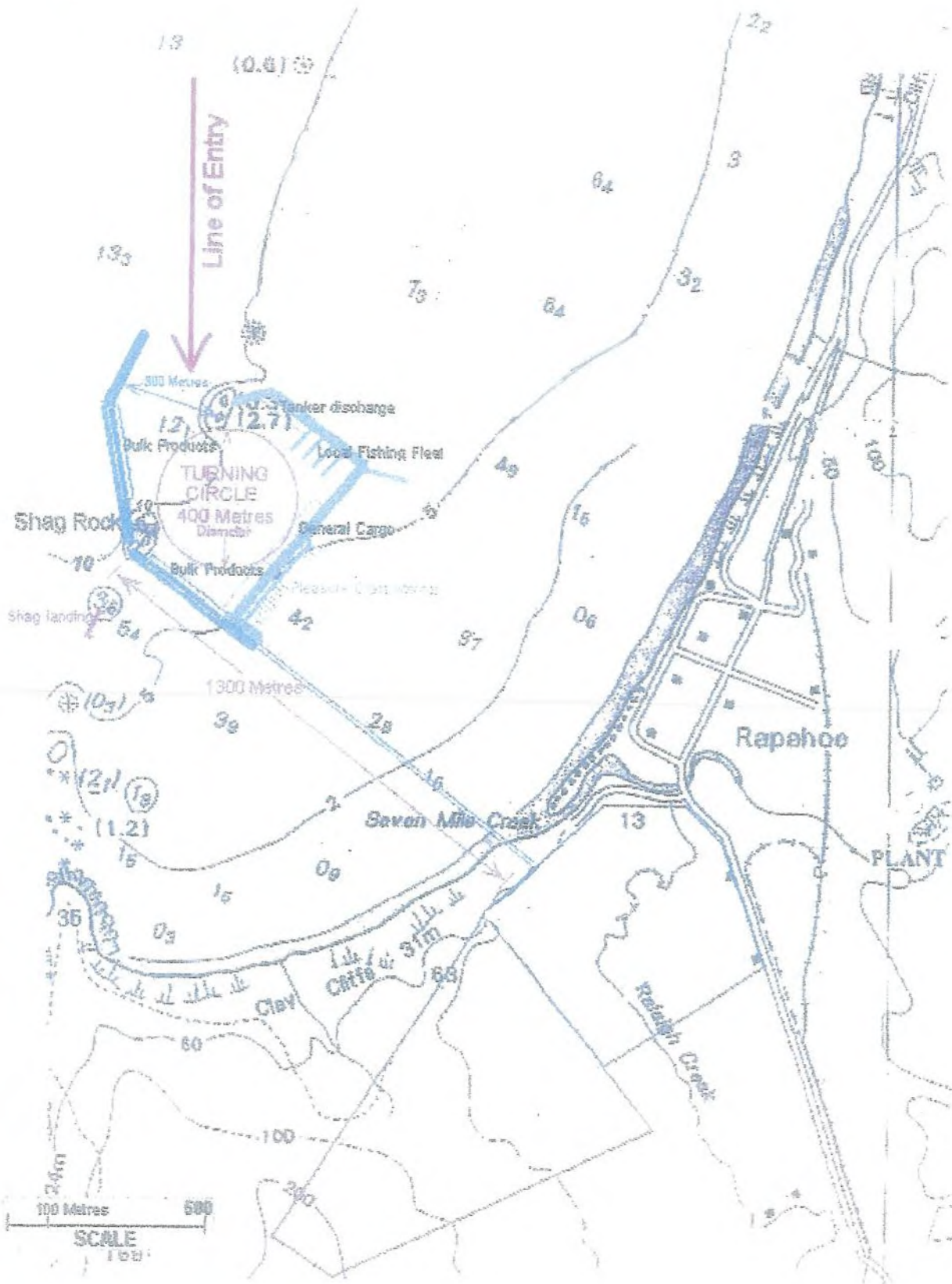

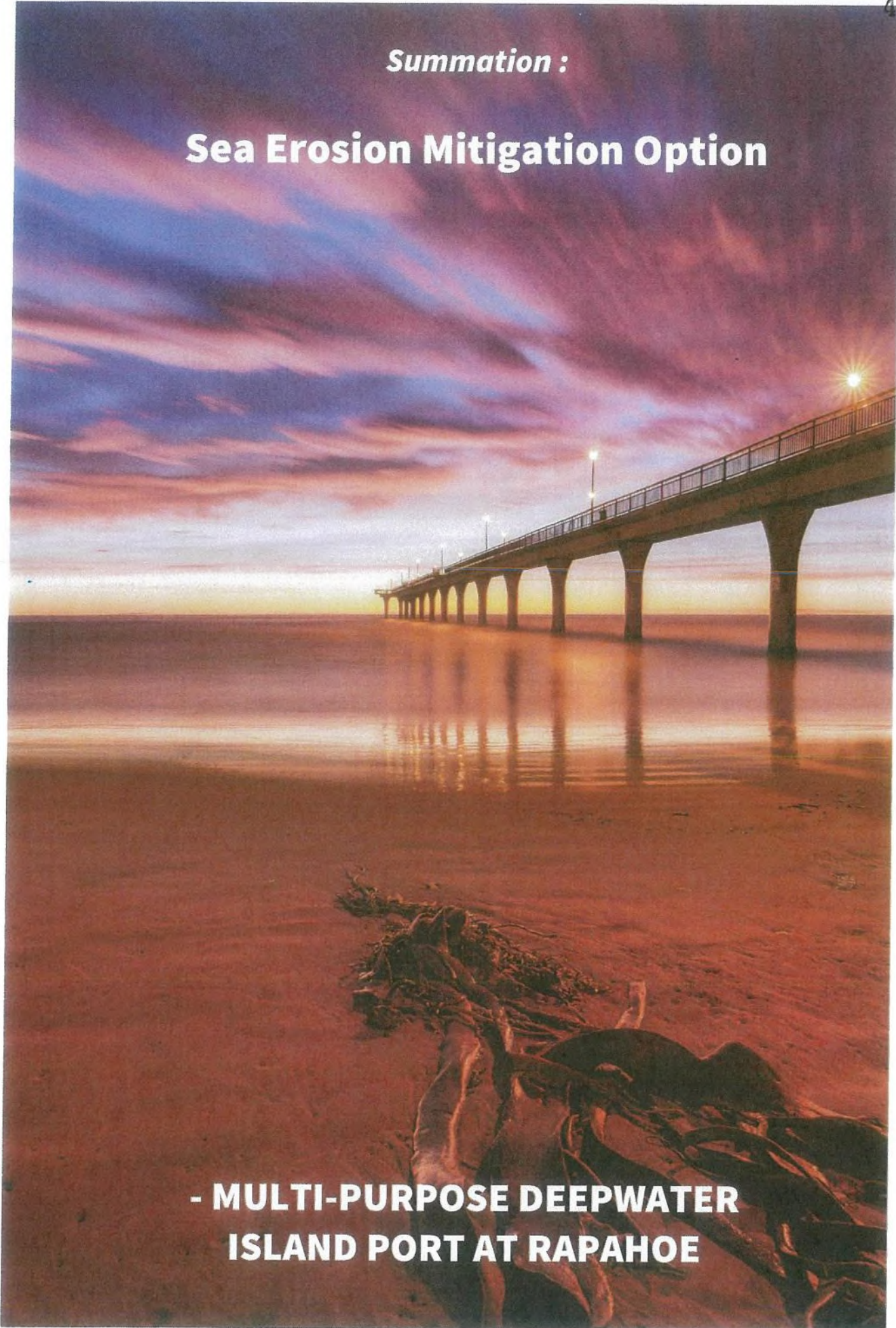

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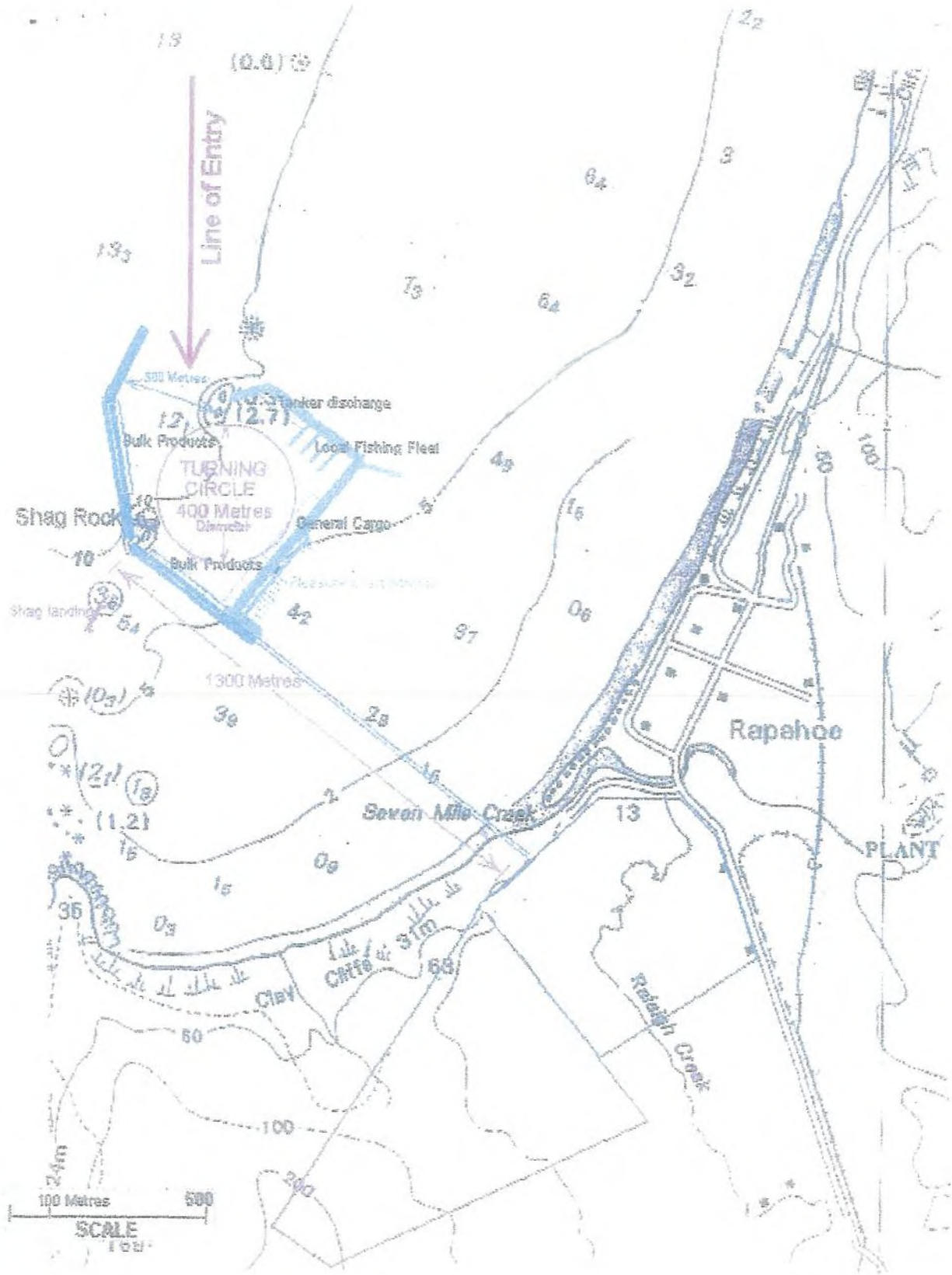
