

Wayne Moen also asked if the local community was comfortable with the level of hydrological information being supplied both prior to and during flood events.

It was generally felt by all locals present that if a further recorder station was constructed at the upstream "Big Bend" of the Karamea River that this would give them a 5 - 6 hour warning rather than the 2 – 2.5 hour warning time as at present.

It was also mentioned that any potential "trouble spots" or weaknesses in the stopbank structure could be discussed when an inspection took place in the future.

There being no further business the meeting concluded at 7.35pm.
